

# INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

## SOUTH AFRICA:

Travellers that intend to visit the country will need to produce a **Negative Covid-19 PCR test** not older than 72 hours from the time of departure from the country of origin.

Upon arrival, travellers will be screened for any Covid-19 symptoms and might be quarantined at their own expense if screened and tested positive at border.

Travellers will also need to provide proof of accommodation addresses in case they need to self-isolate.

## NAMIBIA:

Travellers that intend to visit the country will need to produce a **Negative PCR Covid-19 test** not older than 7 days from date of testing.

Upon arrival, travellers will be screened for any Covid-19 symptoms and might be quarantined at their own expense if screened and tested positive at border.

Children, from 0 to 5 years of age, are exempt from presenting a COVID-19 test when entering the country.

Travellers will also need to provide proof of accommodation addresses in case they need to self-isolate.

## MOZAMBIQUE:

Travellers that intend to visit the country will need to produce a **Negative Covid-19 PCR test** not older than 72 hours.

The validity of the test for COVID-19 is 14 days, starting from the date of the sample collection for the Mozambican or foreign nationality who need multiple entries into the country in a short period of time or for a short trip abroad.

Children, from 0 to 11 years of age, are exempt from presenting a COVID-19 test when entering the country.

Upon arrival, travellers will be screened for any Covid-19 symptoms.

Travellers will also need to provide proof of accommodation addresses in case they need to self-isolate.

## BOTSWANA:

Travellers that intend to visit the country will need to produce a **Negative Covid-19 PCR test** not older than 72 hours.

The validity of the test for COVID-19 is 14 days, starting from the date of the sample collection for the Mozambican or foreign nationality who need multiple entries into the country in a short period of time or for a short trip abroad.

Children, from 0 to 11 years of age, are exempt from presenting a COVID-19 test when entering the country.

Upon arrival, travellers will be screened for any Covid-19 symptoms.

Travellers will also need to provide proof of accommodation addresses in case they need to self-isolate.

## ZIMBABWE:

Travellers that intend to visit the country will need to produce a **Negative PCR or Negative Rapid Covid-19 test** not older than 48 hours from the time of departure from country of origin.

Upon arrival, travellers will be screened for any Covid-19 symptoms and might be quarantined at their own expense if screened and tested positive at border.

Travellers will also need to provide proof of accommodation addresses in case they need to self-isolate.
