

# INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

## SOUTH AFRICA:

Travelling to and from the Republic from neighbouring countries is allowed:

Please note that "regulations of persons entering the country to contain the spread of Covid-19" which demanded either vaccination certificates or recent negative PCR tests, or proof of recovery from Covid-19, from all travellers older than 12 entering South Africa, is no longer applicable.

## NAMIBIA:

The current epidemiological situation as of today no longer supports the retention of the entry requirements into Namibia of a vaccination certificate and a negative PCR test result.

## MOZAMBIQUE:

Travellers that intend to visit the country will need to produce a **Negative Covid-19 PCR test** not older than 72 hours.

The validity of the test for COVID-19 is 14 days, starting from the date of the sample collection for the Mozambican or foreign nationality who need multiple entries into the country in a short period of time or for a short trip abroad.

Children, from 0 to 11 years of age, are exempt from presenting a COVID-19 test when entering the country.

Upon arrival, travellers will be screened for any Covid-19 symptoms.

Travellers will also need to provide proof of accommodation addresses in case they need to self-isolate.

Please note of the following for Gaborone:

Immediate COVID-19 testing of unvaccinated or partially vaccinated people who present themselves at ports of entry, will no longer be conducted. This means that unvaccinated or partially vaccinated people will now only require a 72 hour negative PCR test result to be allowed entry into Botswana. However, anyone presenting themselves at ports of entry, without the requisite documents (COVID-19 vaccination card or 72 hour negative PCR test result), will be tested on arrival, at own cost and if positive, isolated for 5 days within the district of the port of entry.
